# 4. Planned publications: 2012/2013

- Discussion on publication of presented papers during the workshop:
- Both full, short notice and light papers (short and ad hoc papers presented during the workshop) should be published in an appropriate format.
- Not all contributions have to be classified as scientific papers. No one objected to this plan.

- Both PPT-presentations in PDF format and written papers will be accessible on the commission homepage. Nathaniel Kelso will assist in PDF collection and assembling of PPT-presentations.
- All contributions will be managed as well as edited by the workshop hosts in New Zealand and in coordination with the commission on mountain cartography.
- All the unfinished as well as the more complete contributions will be reviewed and coordinated by the editors together with members of the commission.
- Non-native English contributions will be checked Various native speakers of the commission volunteered to assist.
- The following procedures and deadlines were presented:
  - December 2012 deadline for submission of revised and finalized papers
  - December to January 2013 review process
  - January to February 2013 text refinement by native English speakers
  - February to March 2013 publication layout for print and digital format
  - April 2013 printing and digital publication on web-site
- Every workshop participant and first named contributor will receive a printed copy.
- Printed publication must be available for the upcoming ICA Conference in Dresden 2013
- Format of publication: If possible color printed version otherwise black and white with color pdfs on website. Final review process by commission members. Permission for print from ICA will be applied for by chair of commission as soon as all information from editors is available. Furthermore financial support via ICA will be taken into consideration.
- Extended report on the workshop for ICA newsletter will be submitted as soon as possible
